**Please note:** Registration Forms will **ONLY** be accepted with your child's Roman Catholic Baptismal Certificate attached.

**If your child was baptised in St Mochta's Church**, please fill in the Date of Birth and Baptismal details on the Registration form. If you have a copy of the Baptismal Certificate at hand please bring it along with you to Registration.

**For children baptised outside of St Mochta's Church**, a Baptismal Certificate **must be presented with this registration form** before your child can be enrolled on the Preparation Programme.
