



IPAD Built-in Settings

The first thing you can do is enable Restrictions to prevent your child's access to specific features. To do this, simply tap **Settings > General > Restrictions** and tap **Enable Restrictions** and enter a 4-digit passcode. To disable restrictions, tap **Disable Restrictions**, then re-enter your passcode. If you forget your passcode, you must restore the iPad.

When restrictions are enabled, the following features or apps can be restricted:

- Safari
- YouTube
- Camera (this will also disable FaceTime)
- FaceTime
- iTunes
- Ping
- Installing apps
- Deleting apps

The following settings can be prevented:

- Location Services
- Accounts (Mail, Contacts, Calendars, iCloud, and Twitter)

The following content types can be prevented:

- Ratings (Note: Not all countries have a rating system.)
- Music and podcasts
- Movies
- TV shows
- Apps
- In-App Purchases
