



iPod Touch and iPhone



- Tap the **Settings** icon on the iPod Touch / iPhone to open the settings menu
- Open the **General** menu by tapping on it, then tap **Restrictions**
- Tap **Enable Restrictions** and then enter a 4 digit code when prompted. Once the code is entered, restrictions are enabled
- Tap the **On** switch for any applications you want to restrict. This will change the switch to **Off** and hide those applications from the home screen. Controls have been successfully activated.
 - This will allow you to restrict the following:
 - Songs with explicit lyrics
 - Safari (web browser). **Note** If you choose to restrict Safari, you block **all** internet surfing on the device
 - YouTube
 - iTunes
 - Installing Apps
 - Camera
- You can disable restrictions if necessary by tapping the **Disable Restrictions** button on the Restrictions setting page, then entering your four-digit passcode

Warning If you forget the pass code, you will have to reset the iPod Touch / iPhone
